Weather Update

The freezer door opened on November 8, and for two weeks the central and northern U.S. as well as southern Canada found themselves dominated by a series of unrelenting arctic high-pressure systems that brought severe cold.

The first wave reached the southern Plains on November 10; west winds drove Lubbock's high on the 10th to a record 87 degrees just ahead of the cold surge. The leading edge of the arctic blast, the frontal boundary, was even visible on National Weather Service radar as the sharp density change between warm and cold air was detected.

Buffalo Batter & Buried in Lake-Effect Snow

Epic early-season snows, truly a once-in-a lifetime event for the month of November, encased Buffalo, New York during the week before Thanksgiving. Massive drifts stranded drivers in their cars and made thousands of people prisoners in their own homes. The lake-effect lockout claimed numerous lives including two drivers whose pleas for help went unanswered (crews could not get to them). The city was literally strangled by the snow and commerce came to a virtual standstill. As of press time a total of 13 deaths were blamed on it. Southern Buffalo and the adjacent suburbs fared the worst.
